SPRING CLEANUP



Our Spring Cleanup has been scheduled for Saturday, April 30th. Roll off dumpsters will be placed at the following locations for residents to bring items for disposal.

- Riverdale Park 8:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.
- Golden Spike Park 8:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.
- 525 West 4800 South 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

At each location there will be two dumpsters: one for green waste and one for other items. When unloading, please follow these steps:

- Tree limbs must be tied into bundles 6 feet long or less.
- Please bring enough help to unload quickly.
- Children must remain in vehicles for safety reasons.
- Items not accepted: tires, chemicals, paint, dirt, concrete, rocks, batteries, pesticides, drums, and hazardous waste.

Hazardous Waste Disposal

Although hazardous waste is not accepted at the cleanup locations there are several options available to residents for disposal:

- **Les Schwab Tire** located at 627 Riverdale Road will accept used tires, batteries, and oil from Riverdale residents.
- **Weber County Transfer Station** located at 867 W. Wilson Lane will be holding hazardous waste disposal days every third Saturday of the month from April to Sept., from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Homeowners wishing to burn must have an onsite inspection from the Riverdale Fire Department and have a burn permit issued. DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITY IN RIVERDALE CITY



RC Willey is preparing to do an exterior remodel of their store. Plans include providing a new look to the storefront and new landscaping.

In-N-Out Burger is planning to build in the parking lot in front of the old Toys-R-U's building. All approvals have been issued. Construction is projected to begin in April.



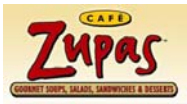
Jiffy Lube will soon be under construction south of McDonalds on 900 West. The city has issued the building permit. Construction will begin soon.



7-Eleven will open a store in the vacant gas station on the northeast corner of Riverdale Rd. and 300 West. Plans include adding onto the existing building. Construction has begun.



Construction has begun on a new building south of the Goodwood Barbeque building along Riverdale Road. It will house two restaurants: Noodles & Company and Café Zupas. Projected completion of the building shell is the end of April. Tenant finish work will then begin.



Aunt Nancy's Assisted Care Facility

Plans are in the works to build a new assisted living care facility called Aunt Nancy's. It will be built on the northeast corner of Freeway Park Drive and Ritter Drive.
