TAKE PRIDE IN RIVERDALE WEEK

The week of April 20th - 25th has been designated as "Take Pride in Riverdale Week." This is a week-long effort to help cleanup and beautify our city. City Council Member Braden Mitchell is overseeing this activity and is coordinating with local church groups, service clubs, and the Utah Military Academy to join in the cleanup effort. A contest is being planned to award prizes for the most improved yard or property. Dumpsters will be provided in the parks on Saturday, April 25th to dispose of the cleanup waste. LUNCH WITH THE MAYOR

On Thursday, April 30th approximately six 6th grade students and a teacher/parent from each of the elementary schools in Riverdale will be involved with a "Lunch with the Mayor." The selected students from Good Foundations Academy, Riverdale Elementary and Riverdale students from Washington Terrace Elementary will be picked up by Riverdale City Police and Fire Department vehicles and transported to the Riverdale Fire Station for a lunch with the Mayor. Along with lunch, the students will learn about the operation of our city government from members of our city staff and from the Mayor. The students will also have an opportunity to share any concerns they might have with our city and to give suggestions and ideas for improvement. I have seen this activity done in two cities in Davis County with great success and feel it is an opportunity for our school-age children to learn more about the community they live in. Next year the goal is to do these lunches quarterly to involve more students.

LIVE FIT RIVERDALE

Live Fit Riverdale will start during the month of April. This is the second year for this community-wide health and wellness activity. Once again it is being planned by a group of volunteers along with help from the city staff. This activity was very well attended last year and those participating enjoyed the activities. SPRING CLEANUP

Our Spring Cleanup has been scheduled for Saturday, April 25th. Roll off dumpsters will be placed at the following locations for residents to bring items for disposal.



- Riverdale Park 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.
- Golden Spike Park 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.
- 525 West 4800 South 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

Two dumpsters will be at each area, one for green waste and one for other items. When unloading, please follow these steps:

- Tree limbs must be tied into bundles 6 feet long or less.
- Please bring enough help to unload quickly.
- Children must remain in vehicles for safety reasons.
- **Items not accepted:** tires, chemicals, paint, dirt, concrete, rocks, batteries, pesticides, drums, and hazardous waste.

Hazardous Waste Disposal

Hazardous waste is not accepted at the cleanup locations, but can be disposed of at the Weber County Transfer Station, 867 W. Wilson Lane. Household hazardous waste disposal days are every third Saturday of the month, April to Sept, from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Take Pride in Riverdale FAQ's

If I don't want to enter the "Most Improved Yard" contest, can I still get volunteer help cleaning up my yard? Yes. Just let them know when you call the Community Center.

Can I enter the contest even if I don't need any volunteer help? Yes.

What are the dates to sign up? Residents can sign up from now until April 16th.

How do I sign up? Simply call the Community Center at 801-621-6084.

Do I have to be present while volunteers are working in my yard? It would be best if the property owner was present so that they can help to direct the work.

When are volunteers available to help with my yard? Volunteers will be available on Wednesday 4/22 from 8:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. and on Saturday 4/25 from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

What items can be disposed of in the dumpsters? Please refer to the Spring Cleanup article on page one or visit the city website for a list of approved waste.

When will the yards in the contest be judged? Judging will be Saturday May 2nd.

How will the yards be judged? The yards will be judged by the Riverdale Youth City Council. They will use before and after pictures and possibly visit the properties.

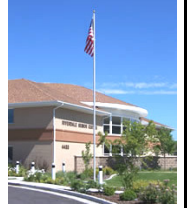
