CITIZEN SURVEY

The elected officials and employees of Riverdale City strive to provide excellent services, with accountability, to our citizens. To help us understand how we are meeting this objective the city periodically conducts a Citizen Survey. The Citizen Survey assesses citizen satisfaction with the results of our work and identifies areas where programs are performing above or below expectations. The 2014 Riverdale City Citizen Survey was conducted in October-November. In the survey, citizens were asked to rate and provide comments on services provided by the city. There were a total of 566 surveys returned to the city, a response rate of 17%. I would like to thank each of you who took the time to be involved in your community by filling out and returning the survey. The results of the survey will be ready for review by the end of December on the city website.

WINTERTIME REMINDERS

- ❄️ **Clear snow from sidewalks:** City ordinance requires that homeowners, renters and businesses clear sidewalks in front of their property after each snowstorm. 
- ❄️ **Do not place snow into the street:** State and municipal ordinances prohibit shoveling, blowing or plowing snow into any public street, when removing it from sidewalks, driveways and parking lots.
- ❄️ **No parking on the street:** City ordinance requires that cars be parked off the streets during snow storms and winter nights. Violators may be cited and their car may be towed.
- ❄️ **Clear snow from in front of your mailbox:** This allows for mail delivery.
- ❄️ **Uncover fire hydrants:** If there is a fire hydrant in front of your property make sure that it can be easily spotted and is not covered by snow.
- ❄️ **Remove garbage and recycle cans from the street:** This should be done as soon as possible after they are emptied.
- ❄️ **Keep streets clear:** Please remove basketball hoops, trailers, and any other obstructions out of the street.
- ❄️ **Snow plowing:** Every effort is made to plow streets as soon as possible. Please exercise patience as main roads are cleared followed by the subdivisions.
