#### Riverdale Flooding 2011 Update

We hope this will be the last update necessary for this year. As of this writing, river flows have been down for a while with the water being controlled by the operators of the upstream dams to help with downstream flooding, but are expected to go back up with the sudden hot temperatures. We continue to be hopeful that we won't have any more problems in homes and that we can soon reopen the portions of the trail that are not damaged.

One situation that has come to light through this is that many of our residents are flushing leaves and grass clippings down the gutters and into the storm drains. Please do not engage in doing this as it has plugged up our pumps in the River Glen subdivision several times as we try to help keep water out of our resident's homes this spring. It takes a lot of time and effort to clean them out so they can be effective again.

#### 50 Years of Fun

Can you believe a new golf course opening in February? That is what Ernie Schneider Sr. and Ernie Jr. did in the winter of 1961 when they opened the Riverside Golf Course. They bought 40 acres from Ralph and Ida Ritter and transformed it into a 9 hole golf course. The mild winter that year allowed the grass to be cut in February and play to begin thereafter. The club house foundation was part of the old barn and with the new renovations and expansions, the old roots were left into the design.

Ernie Sr. passed away in 1968, but Ernie Jr. and his family have carried on the wonderful tradition for our community. The course has gone through a few changes over the years. The lakeside par 3 course was added and later additional land was purchased and the course was converted into the 18 holes we have today. The original layout had to change when the freeway was constructed and cut right through the old hole numbers two and three.

Many people affectionately call the golf course "Ernie World" because of the friendly open playable format they have. They will go out of their way to accommodate groups and players. So enjoy the 50 year experience and maybe for a nominal charge you can get an anniversary collectors golf ball!

In 2009 we co-named South Weber Drive as Ernie Schneider Drive in honor of the many contributions the Schneider family have made to the community. We extend our congratulations and appreciation to the Riverside Golf Course for 50 great years in Riverdale!

### ELECTION INFORMATION

The filing period for the November Municipal Election is now open. Three City Council seats are up for election. Each Council seat has a four year term.

### FIRE RESTRICTIONS IN PLACE

Riverdale City Fire Chief Doug Illum has declared that fire restrictions are now in place along the Weber River corridor within city boundaries. The restrictions include no open fires, no open flames, no cigarettes, and no fireworks along the river corridor. The restrictions have been put in place due to the heavy vegetation along the river corridor which is now beginning to dry out and die due to hotter temperatures. The restrictions take place immediately and will continue to be in effect until October 31, 2011.



### DON'T DUMP WASTE IN STORM DRAINS

Residents, please do not allow anything other than water to enter into the storm drain system. With the high level of the Weber River, the city has been pumping water out of the storm drain system to help prevent basement flooding in the River Glen subdivision. Often the pumps have become clogged with litter and grass clippings that have been washed down the gutters and into the storm drain. Please, after mowing your lawn, sweep or blow grass clippings back onto the lawn. This will help prevent the clippings from getting into the storm drain system.



Also, remember that anything washed into the gutter will end up in the storm drain system and drain directly into the Weber River. Examples of contaminants include: draining a radiator and washing the antifreeze into the gutter, cleaning a paint brush in the gutter, and excess lawn fertilizer washed into the gutter.

Please exercise caution and remember, storm drains are for excess rain runoff, not for dumping waste.

## CITY HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Riverdale City buildings will be closed to observe the Pioneer Day Holiday on Monday, July 25<sup>th</sup>. The Community Center front desk will be open from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., but the gym and exercise room will be closed. There will be no change in our garbage pickup for that week.



## SEWER USAGE FEE INCREASE

Although Riverdale City operates and maintains our own sewer collection system, the processing of sewage is done at the wastewater treatment plant operated by the Central Weber Sewer Improvement District. The majority of the sewer fee included in your city utility bill is for the operation of the treatment plant which is charged to the city by the District. The treatment plant is currently undergoing a \$140 million upgrade and expansion. To finance the project, the District has increased the rates it charges to the city which has forced the city to increase the sewer usage fees we charge to our customers.

The implementation of the sewer usage fee increase will be effective July 1<sup>st</sup> and will be reflected on the August utility bill. The new sewer usage fees are: residential customers - \$18.82, mobile homes - \$15.31, multifamily - \$22.93 and commercial customers pay based on their water consumption based.

## BAG YOUR CLIPPINGS

When you mow your lawn, please put grass clippings in a garbage bag before you place them in the garbage can. When grass clippings are dumped directly into the garbage can they can clump and get compacted by other garbage preventing the can from being completely emptied. By placing them into a garbage bag it is much easier for our garbage hauler to completely empty the can.

Best Buy has announced that they will be relocating their store to the former Circuit City building.



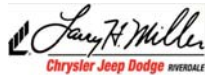
In-N-Out Burger has purchased the property in front of the old Toys-R-Us building. Construction of the restaurant has been delayed.
