Refreshments will be furnished and served by Sam's Club of Riverdale. This is always a very meaningful program as we pause to remember those who have served in our military and have preserved the many freedoms of this great nation. PRESERVING RIVERDALE'S HISTORY

Driving through Riverdale, there are a lot of changes currently being made to our business district with many more changes on the horizon. Also, many changes have taken place, throughout our community, since this area was first founded in 1850. Other changes will continue to take place in our city in the future, including a new park. The new park property has been purchased and paid for and a design has been completed. Options to fund the park construction are being explored at the present time. The Weber School District has made it known that they expect to build a new elementary school to replace the existing school on 4400 South. This is expected to take place sometime around 2021-2022. The school could be built near the present location or in an entirely new location.

TIME TO WINTERIZE

Our Riverdale Public Works Department would like to remind residents to winterize your lawn sprinkler systems before the freezing temperatures settle in. This can be done by draining or blowing out with an air compressor any water that remains in the sprinkler lines. Sprinkler lines are typically not buried deep enough to prevent freezing. Each spring we have residents surprised by large water bills due to unknown leaks in their lawn sprinkler system caused by broken lines that froze during the winter.



If you have a swamp cooler, please remember to winterize it as well. Turn off and drain the water line running to the swamp cooler at the valve. This will prevent freezing and leaking due to a broken water line.

Avoid the cost of excess water usage and the repair of your sprinkler system or swamp cooler by properly winterizing your systems.

NEW UTILITY PAYMENT APP AVAILABLE

Riverdale City's online utility payment partner, Xpress Bill Pay, has introduced a new iOS mobile app. The free app is available for the iPhone, iPad or iPod touch from the Apple App Store, and requires iOS 8.0 or later. They are currently working on Android and Windows Apps and hope to offer them soon.



The new app will offer many of the features found with their current website, including:

- Pay your bills in real-time
- Pay with a credit card, checking account, etc.
- Sign-up for paperless billing
- Never miss a bill again with Auto Pay
- Update your payment information
- View your billing and payment history
- Receive up-to-the-minute account alerts

PLEASE CLEAN STREET GUTTERS

As you clean up the Fall leaves please clean the leaves out of the street gutters in front of your home. Leaves left in the street gutters will cause two problems:



First, leaves can be washed down the street gutter and accumulate in the storm drain system. This can cause the storm drains to become clogged leading to potential flooding during a heavy rain.

Second, when street sweeping, accumulated leaves in the street gutters will greatly reduce the ability of the sweeper to properly clean the street and can also cause the machine to become clogged.

Below are tips to help you prepare for the coming winter months:



Things to do and items to have available in your home:

- Get your furnace checked by a certified heating contractor.
- Clean your chimney if you burn wood or coal.
- Have a flashlight and portable radio with extra batteries on hand.
- Have an emergency heating source and heating fuel.
- Keep a fire extinguisher in your home.
- Store extra food, water, medicine, and baby items.
- Ensure smoke and carbon monoxide detectors work and have new batteries.
- Keep first-aid supplies on hand.

- Boys 7th-9th grades: November 1st - December 10th.



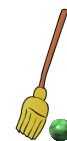
