UDOT Region One Road Construction Report for September 23-29, 2016

Ogden-- The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) advises motorists of the following road construction and maintenance activities that may cause traffic impacts in the state's Northern Region.

Davis County

Bountiful

Sept 23-29: On 400 North, From Main Street to 500 West, crews are scheduled to prep and pour driveway approaches during the day on the north side between 350 West and 500 West. North side driveways will reopen as soon as the concrete has reached strength. Crews are also scheduled to lower a drainage line on the south side of 400 North between 100 West and Main Street. Additional nighttime paving is beginning between 200 West and 500 West, has been rescheduled due to wet weather forecast for this weekend. Crews also continue material placement and grading in preparation for paving on the south side of 400 North between Main Street and 200 West in early October. Meanwhile, from 500 West to I-15, daytime activities through October include asphalt removal, excavation, and roadway grading in the center of the road. Crews are scheduled to pour concrete in this section at night as early as October 2. Use the 500 West access for businesses on the northwest corner of the intersection including Ramblin' Roads, Elks Lodge, and the Downunder Club. Centerville

Sept 27: The Region One asphalt paving crew will be conducting paving operations on Parrish Lane (SR-105) in Centerville, between the Legacy Parkway and I-15., on Tuesday, September 29. Crews will be working from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. One lane will be closed with flaggers directing traffic. Motorists with time-sensitive travel should consider alternate routes.

Kaysville

Sept 23-29: Work is underway on the I-15 Lagoon to Layton Parkway auxiliary lane addition project. Beginning Saturday, September 24, from 10 p.m. through Monday, September 26, at 4 a.m., the two southbound outside lanes near Layton Parkway will be closed to drill and prep for a foundation base for a large sign. This is a tight work zone, so the two lanes will be closed this weekend. Nightly, beginning Monday night, September 26, from 7 p.m. through Saturday, October 1, at 4 a.m., crews will close the two southbound inside lanes near Layton Parkway for storm drain installation in the median. This will affect the HOV and fast lanes. Finally, the southbound on-ramp to I-15 at Layton Parkway has an abrupt merge, and northbound I-15 has reduced shoulders and a steep drop off from approximately Shepard Lane to Layton Parkway. Be wary of these conditions. Syracuse

Sept 23-29: On 2000 West (SR-108) in Syracuse, homes acquired by UDOT are in the process of being demolished. Impacts to traffic are minimal, but be alert as trucks will be entering and exiting 2000 West at locations throughout this project corridor. *No salvage of building materials is allowed on these premises.* Roadway design is nearing completion. Layton

Sept 23-29: Work on the new I-15 interchange at Hill Field Road (SR-232) in Layton is complete, and the new interchange is open. Over the next month crews will be completing landscaping, signs and other "punch list" items required to bring this project to its conclusion. Lanes may be closed or restricted occasionally for shoulder work, so motorists should be watchful for workers and equipment adjacent to open lanes. Sept 23-29: On Hill Field Road (SR-232), crews continue to place concrete between 1900 North to 2800 North. Once concrete has been placed it requires approximately 14 days to reach full strength. Asphalt removal is now underway between 2800 North and SR-193. Crews will begin preparing this section for concrete over the next week. Concrete placement in this section may begin as early as September 28. Traffic is currently shifted to the west side of the roadway and will remain in that configuration through October. One travel lane in each direction will be maintained on SR-232 and at the Antelope Drive intersection for this work. Residents with specific issues can call the project hotline at 801-859-3770 for assistance. Motorists should expect heavy delays from 7 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. and from 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. due to school traffic. Please use alternate routes, particularly if travel is time-sensitive, to avoid delays. For information, email sr232@utah.gov, or visit the project website, udot.utah.gov/go/sr232.

Sept 23-29: Construction crews will continue to repave the main line of SR-109 (East Gentile Street and Oak Hills Drive) through the week. Residents can expect paving crews in the area Saturday through Monday from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m., and then starting on Tuesday construction crews will resume night work from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. During construction times traffic will be reduced by one lane. On East Gentile Street between Main Street and 1350 East, traffic will be reduced to one lane open in each direction during construction. On Oak Hills Drive, a pilot car will guide traffic in alternating directions during construction. Motorists should expect a maximum of 15 minute delays during night work hours and may want to consider an alternative route. Weber County

Riverdale

Sept 23-29: Riverdale City is building a pedestrian bridge over I-15, at 4400 South in Riverdale. Single lanes will be closed intermittently, with a full closure of I-15 planned in overnight hours in October. Motorists should watch for nightly lane closures or restrictions, and move to open lanes as they approach this project. It is expected to be completed by November 4. Ogden

Sept 23-29: On I-15, between Riverdale (I-84) and Farr West (SR-134), Crews have completed paving operations on the on- and off ramps and mainline I-15 from the I-84 merge to 2700 North. Crews will be working nights painting at the bridges throughout the project corridor this week. Watch for intermittent lane closures at various interchanges. This activity is weather dependent. Schedule is subject to change. Traffic delays are possible where crews and equipment are positioning to complete their work. Motorists should reduce speed when traveling through this zone as trucks and equipment will be entering and exiting the freeway. Marriott-Slaterville

Sept 23-29: Crews are installing left-turn and pedestrian upgrades at SR-126 & Pioneer Road, Marriott-Slaterville. They expect to finish this week. One lane may be restricted or closed intermittently to facilitate this work. Slow down as you approach this intersection and be prepared to stop.

Morgan County

Morgan

Sept 26: The Region One asphalt paving crew will be conducting paving operations at the Ranch Interchange at milepost 106 in Morgan, on Monday, September 26. Crews will be working from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. One lane will be closed with flaggers directing traffic. Motorists with time-sensitive travel may encounter delays and should consider alternate routes.

Box Elder County

Farr West to Brigham City

Sept 23-29: Crews are expanding I-15 by one lane in both directions, between Hot Springs and Brigham City. In order for the outer auxiliary lanes to be constructed, construction crews have shifted motorists to new concrete pavement in several areas along the corridor on I-15 from Farr West to Brigham City in both directions. Crews continue bridge activities, paint/tape installation, concrete paving and shoulder work along the construction corridor through late November 2016, north and southbound, with both day and nighttime activities Sunday through Saturday. The speed limit has been reduced to 65 mph throughout this corridor, and lanes are narrowed. Trucks with loads wider than 11' are required to have an escort while driving through the construction corridor, so contact the Perry Port of Entry for wide load routing instructions. Perry

Sept 23-29: Utility work is being conducted through the fall at the Perry Rest Area on northbound I-15. During this work the rest area will remain open, but only limited parking will be available. For more information call the project hotline at 801-712-3030, or email i15boxelder@utah.gov.

Sept 23-29: Bridge work continues at the I-15 Bridge located at 2950 South, in Perry. Motorists on 2950 South may experience intermittent closures of this roadway on Friday, September 23. Intermittent single lane configurations on north and southbound I-15 may also take place near the bridge. The detour route for traffic on 2950 South is 2700 South. Willard

Sept 23-29: At 750 North in Willard, bridge work is projected to continue through fall 2016. Intermittent, single lane traffic for motorists traveling east and west under the bridge is now in place through September 30. Intermittent single lane configurations are also in place on north and southbound I-15 near the 750 North Bridge. For traffic under the bridge, a detour route will be available via US-89. For more info call the project hotline at 801-712-3030, or email i15boxelder@utah.gov.

Sept 23-29: Bridge work continues on the 7800 South, a full bridge closure is now in place through September 30. Flagging personnel may be onsite to direct east and west direct traffic under the bridge on Wednesday September 28. Intermittent, single lane configurations north and southbound will take place on I-15 near the 7800 South Bridge. The detour route is 8700 South to 1500 West. Sept 23-29: Bridge work at 8700 South is projected to continue through fall 2016. A full bridge closure is now in place through September 30. Area motorists and residents may experience an increase in noise, light, dust, vibration, construction personnel and vehicles in the area. Traffic will detour via 7800 South to 1500 West. Hot Springs

Sept 29: On Thursday, September 29, from noon to 4 p.m., crews will repave the southbound return lane from SR-126 to US-89 in Willard. During this paving operation, the return lane will be CLOSED to all traffic. Northbound US-89 traffic should use the 2700 North Interchange in Farr West, and proceed east to US-89 to access South Willard/Hot Springs and Pleasant View locations during this closure.

Brigham City

Sept 29: On Thursday, September 29, 200 South (SR-90) in Brigham City will be CLOSED from Main Street (SR-13) to the US-89/91 Ramp in Box Elder Canyon, from 7 a.m. to noon, while crews conduct roadway resurfacing operations. During this closure, all traffic should detour south, with EB traffic bound for Logan-Cache Valley using US-89/91 at Main Street in Perry.

Sept 23-25: Crews are paving the intersection of US-91 and 1100 West in Brigham City. During this work, one or two lanes may be closed based

Honeyville

Sept 23-29: Paving is complete on a project on I-15, between Honeyville and West Tremonton, but crews are still conducting work on bridge decks and placing rumble strips into the pavement. I-15 is currently reduced to one lane while crews are installing the rumble strips or grinding pavement on the bridge decks. Guardrail and delineator installation is also ongoing. Tremonton

Sept 28: The Region One asphalt paving crew will be conducting paving operations on Main Street in Tremonton (SR-102) from 300 East to approximately 600 East, on Thursday, September 28. Crews will be working from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. One lane will be closed with flaggers directing traffic. Motorists with timesensitive travel may encounter delays and should consider alternate routes.

Howell

Sept 23-29: Work is underway on work to replace a failing culvert on SR-83 (Faust Valley Road), on the north side of the Orbital ATK Flight Systems complex. One way traffic controlled by flaggers is being maintained on 12000 North (SR-83) at the culvert site. Motorists should expect short delays, and those with time sensitive travel will want to consider alternate routes. For more information or other concerns, call 801-620-1641.
